

BYLAW NO. 1155

A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF NORTH BATTLEFORD IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN TO REGULATE HUNTING, SHOOTING AND TRAPPING WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF NORTH BATTLEFORD.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to regulate hunting, shooting and trapping within the boundaries of the City of North Battleford:

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BATTLEFORD IN OPEN MEETING ASSEMBLED, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the Hunting and Trapping Bylaw.
2. In this Bylaw:
  - a) "Hunt" or "Hunting" includes capturing, chasing, staking, wounding, killing, searching for, trapping, attempting to trap, or setting snares for any animal or bird to which this Bylaw applies.
3. No person shall hunt, trap, take, shoot at, wound or kill any animal or bird within the Corporate boundaries or limits of the City of North Battleford unless he is expressly authorized to do so by this Bylaw.
4. No person shall have in his possession, set out, use or employ a snare or trap of any type whatsoever for the capture or destruction of any animal or bird within the limits of the City of North Battleford unless expressly authorized to do so by this Bylaw.
5. Any Peace Officer including any person authorized to enforce the provisions of the Game Act of the Province of Saskatchewan who finds a person violating or who finds that a person has violated any of the provisions of this Bylaw may seize any shotgun, rifle, net, trap or other implement of shooting or hunting that is being used or was used in connection with the violation and that is found in the possession of that person and may use it as evidence at his Trial.
6. If no prosecution for an offence, in respect of which any article or thing is seized under this Bylaw is brought within 30 days after the date of the seizure,

the article or thing seized shall be returned to the person from whom it was seized.

7. A person who violates any of the provisions of this Bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine of not more than \$500.00.
8. No prosecution for the violation of any of the provisions of this Bylaw shall be commenced after six (6) months from the date of the violation.
9. Notwithstanding the provisions of this Bylaw, the Council of the City of North Battleford may give written permission for the snaring, hunting or poisoning of rodents and other animals or birds constituting a nuisance or danger to the health and safety of residents of the City of North Battleford.
10. Where any conflict arises between the provisions of this Bylaw and Bylaw No. 860, being the Bylaw providing for the restraining, regulating and licensing of dogs in the City of North Battleford, the provisions of Bylaw No. 860 as amended shall prevail.
11. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of the final passing thereof.
