Capital Works and UPAR Update: August 9, 2016

108th Street - 10th to 11th Avenue

Boulevard landscaping is planned to begin this week, with asphalt milling and paving to begin next week. Road closures and access disruptions will be in effect once work resumes on the roadway restoration.

St. Laurent Drive - Douglas to McKenzie King Crescent

Crews will complete repairs to watermain valves, fire hydrants, and catch basin pipes this week which will cause short term access disruptions and road closures. Concrete repairs have been completed, and final paving work is scheduled to begin this week and extend into next week, which will result in road closures and access disruptions.

95th Street - Panton Avenue to 19th Avenue

Final paving work is complete.

102nd Street - 16th to 17th Avenue

Roadway restoration work has begun with the construction of the structural granular courses. Concrete work is expected to begin this week, with final paving to follow. This block is open to local traffic, but will be subject to complete closures once work resumes on the roadway. The local drinking water advisory for this block has been lifted.

106th Street - 10th to 11th Avenue

The road is closed, and underground work is nearly complete. Backfilling and cleanup work has been delayed by a few days due to recent rain. If the weather permits, the area will be cleaned up and backfilled this week, with street light work, and roadway restoration planned to begin next week. This block will remain on a local drinking water advisory until further notice.

96th Street - Railway Avenue to 14th Avenue

The 1200 block will be closed and underground work will begin this week. The 1200 block will be connected to temporary water supply and be placed on a local drinking water advisory. The 1300 block will remain open this week, but is planned to be closed next week as the underground work proceeds northward.

<u>Territorial Drive Pathway Paving – Douglas Avenue to 15th Avenue</u>

The pathway is scheduled to be closed for paving August 9th and 10th.

City Hall South Parking Lot Paving

The parking lot immediately south of City Hall is scheduled to be closed for paving August 11th to 16th.

Buhler Avenue Paving

Buhler Avenue, east of Clements Drive is scheduled to be paved August 22nd to August 26th.

Civic Centre Rear Parking Lot

The North parking lot at the back of the Civic Centre is scheduled to be closed for reconstruction work August 22nd to August 31st.

Alley Reconstruction

The lane between Henderson Drive and Amos Drive, from Territorial Drive to Buhler Avenue, is scheduled to be closed for reconstruction work September 12th to September 16th.

Please be reminded:

- Garbage and recycling pickup will be in the back alley while construction is ongoing
- Motorists: please use caution when travelling through the work zones, and respect the safety of workers
- Residents: please stay out of construction areas and supervise children.

Best efforts are made to plan and schedule the projects, but schedule disruptions due to weather and other unforeseen circumstances do occur. The City thanks the public and the affected residents and businesses for their patience and understanding during these important infrastructure rehabilitation projects.
