## Capital Works and UPAR Update: July 22, 2016

### **108th Street – 10th to 11th Avenue**

Concrete curb and sidewalk repairs are complete, and paving and boulevard landscaping is planned for next week.

### **St. Laurent Drive – Douglas to McKenzie King Cres.**

Crews will continue with repairs to watermain valves this week and next week which will cause short term access disruptions and road closures. Concrete repairs have been completed, and final paving work is planned to occur later this summer. Water valve repairs are taking longer than expected due to the discovery of valves that are in very poor condition that need replacement. No further water service disruptions are anticipated, but disruptions are possible depending on the condition of the valves being repaired.

### **95th Street – Pantan Ave to 19th Ave**

Underground work is complete and paving is planned for Thursday and Friday of this week.

### **102nd Street – 16th to 17th Avenue**

Underground work is completed, and roadway restoration will begin Wednesday. It is expected to take approximately 2 weeks to repair curbs and sidewalks and pave. This block will remain closed until concrete repairs are completed. Residents will be disconnected from temporary water services and will remain on a local drinking water advisory until further notice.

### **106th Street 10th to 11th Avenue**

The road is closed, and underground work is underway. Residents are connected to temporary water services and are on a drinking water advisory for the duration of the project. The underground work is expected to last for 3 weeks, with roadway restoration to follow.

The City reminds motorists to use caution when travelling through the work zones, and respect the safety of workers. The patience and understanding of the public and business owners in affected areas is appreciated during these important rehabilitation projects.

*The Underground Pipeline and Asphalt Replacement (UPAR) program was introduced in 2015 to address the issue for replacement of underground infrastructure and street repaving.*
