The camp will emphasize fair and safe play, while promoting water safety. Campers will be placed into their respective Swim for Life levels based on their most recently completed swimming level. Guidelines:

Beginner Lesson: Floating, Gliding 5-10m and beginning front and back swims.

Intermediate Lesson: throwing assists, tread water 1 ½ minutes, all strokes 10-15m, and working towards 25m+ distance swim.

Advanced Lesson: tread water 3 minutes, all strokes 25-75m, and working towards 300m+ distance swim.
