



UPDATE ON PROPOSED MUNICIPAL REGULATIONS FOR CANNABIS

(March 21, 2018):

1. What is the Municipal Government responsible for?

Land Use and Zoning – The locations where retail and production will be permitted in North Battleford.

2. Will a cannabis retailer open near my home?

Cannabis retail will be prohibited in all residential areas and in neighbourhoods commercial areas.

3. There are many schools, playgrounds and recreational facilities around the City, what if a cannabis retailer locates nearby?

Cannabis retail will have a minimum separation distance from all schools, playgrounds, and municipal recreational facilities.

4. What about cannabis cultivation?

Currently the City of North Battleford allows medical marijuana production and cultivation as a discretionary land use in the heavy industrial zoning district. Council is currently considering the potential risks and benefits of listing cannabis production and cultivation as a permitted land use in the heavy industrial zoning district.

5. Can people consume cannabis in public places?

No. The Provincial Government has released in the legislative framework that cannabis consumption will be explicitly prohibited in public places. The model will be similar to the laws against public alcohol consumption.
