Aquatic Operator

The City of North Battleford has a Full-Time Temporary Aquatic Operator 1 position available in the Parks and Recreation Department. Reporting to the CUplex Manager, this position is responsible for the overall cleanliness of the building, general building maintenance and upkeep, and ensuring the facility is in complete documented compliance with all Dept of Health and Government of Saskatchewan standards and legislation relating to safe operation of pools. Under the guidance of the Aquatic Operator 2, the Aquatic Operator 1 assists with the maintenance and operation of general aquatic equipment such as pumps, filtration systems, controllers etc. Completes general caretaking, janitorial and cleaning duties required to maintain a high standard of cleanliness throughout the facility. Identifies and completes minor building maintenance tasks as needed. Immediately report to the Aquatic Operator 2 and CUplex Manager, any major leaks, mechanical system failures or major maintenance problems. Sets up or takes down program equipment as needed and is responsible for maintenance of proper water chemistry, clarity, documentation as per Saskatchewan legislation- water testing and monitoring logs

- Successful completion of Grade 12 or GED equivalent deemed acceptable by the City
- Ability to swim- float, tread water for 1 minute, dog paddle
- Class 5 Drivers licence with a satisfactory driver abstract
- Willing to attain within 6 months of hire the Level 1 Pool Operator Certificate
- Willing to work towards Pool Operator 2 Certificate. (applicable after 1 year's work experience in the role of Aquatic Operator 1 at the facility)
- Willing to obtain Confined spaces and Fall arrest training within 12 months of hire.
- Willing to obtain Standard First Aid/CPR- AED as offered
- Provide a clear Criminal Record Check with Vulnerable Section upon hire
