



Assistance for Residents with Flood Damage



Due to the severe rain event on August 8th, North Battleford has been designated as an eligible assistance area under the Provincial Disaster Assistance Program (PDAP). This allows residents who experienced damage to apply for assistance.

If your home was damaged during the August 8th rain event:

- Document the damages as much as possible
 - Take pictures
 - Save Invoices
 - Save Receipts or other Proof of Payments
- Determine the extent of your insurance coverage
- If your business experienced flood damage you also might be eligible for assistance, contact PDAP for more info toll free at 1-866-632-4033

As North Battleford is designated, residents may come to City Hall and will be provided the application form. Please keep in mind that gardens, lawns and other landscaping are not considered eligible under PDAP.

The City strongly urges Property owners to take measures to protect their property by:

- ensuring the ground slopes away from structures
- window wells for the basement
- eavestroughs lead away from the foundation
- retaining walls or landscaped berms

There may be assistance for this as well through the Flood Damage Reduction Program. This program is from the Water Security Agency (www.wsask.ca) and aids with the implementation of emergency flood protection measures for communities with **imminent risk of flooding**. For details
